- a) **Key West Senior Center**- Bill Horn, architect will give project update, and possible site areas for artwork. Project Budget- \$528,714. Contract has been executed. **Public Art Budget: \$5,287.14 Art Budget \$ 4,500.**
- b) **Bernstein Park**, Stock Island renovations: Bill Horn, architect. Plans are 95%complete. Will take several months for the bid process. Aprox. \$5 million project. Committee requests discussion regarding possible "eco-art" proposals for site.
- c) **Marathon Court House –Budget \$8,311.05.** RFP for exterior artwork budget is **\$7,200.** Construction (sewer hook-up) is partially completed –Project Management will provide update on completion of onsite construction. Staff has started to draft the RFP, using language provided by County Project management for exterior artwork. Doug Sposito will be our contact. Please note: Non-voting members request a meeting day other than Monday for proposal review.

4. Conch Key Fire Station – Beth update on lighting options

5. Key West Airport – Conference room potentially being constructed within the hallway where the Whitehead St Pottery piece was re-sited. No further etched glass would be needed. Update.

6. Projects Slated for 2016/ 2017: Marathon Library - Plantation Key Court House – Summerland Key Fire Station –Big Pine Key Swimming Hole ...KW Airport – final phase of etched glass project.
