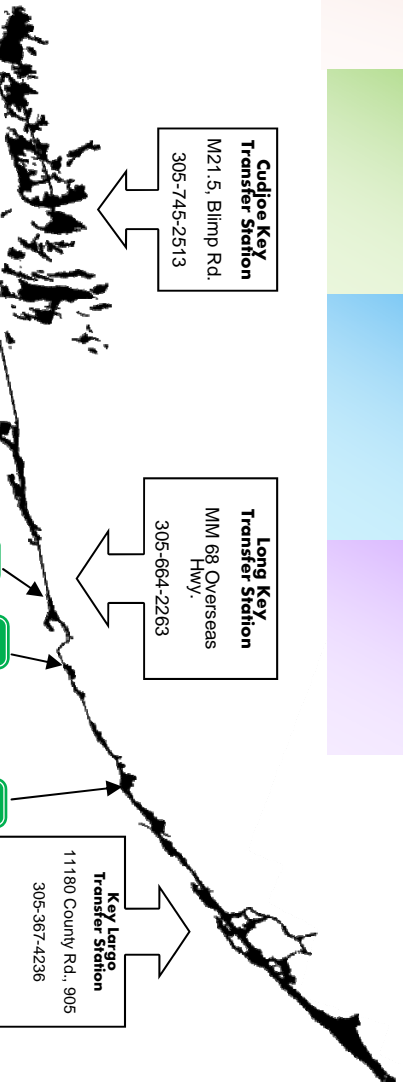

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

- Paint, Stain, Wood preservatives
- Roof tar & Patching compounds
- Adhesives, putty & caulk
- Fiberglass & epoxy resins
- Hydraulic fluids, anti-freeze, waste oil
- Pesticides, fertilizers, weed killers
- Fluorescent/CFL bulbs
- Oily water/gasoline



Electronic Waste

- Televisions, Monitors, Computers
- Printers, Copiers, FAX machines
- Cell Phones, radios, speakers
- Discs, video cassettes, DVD's
- Batteries (car, boat, rechargeable)

HHW and E-Waste require special disposal because they pollute the earth, air and water. They may NOT be put in your recycle cart, they must be taken to a County Transfer Station for disposal

Disposal is FREE FOR RESIDENTS
(some fees and limits may apply)

Business Waste is accepted for a FEE

Plastic

Bottles and jugs

- Water, soda & juice bottles
- Milk and juice jugs
- Ketchup and salad dressing bottles
- Dishwashing liquid bottles & detergent jugs
- Shampoo, soap and lotion bottles



Cups and Containers:

- Yogurt, pudding and fruit cups
- Cutlery, cups, lids & straws
- Margarine, cottage cheese, and other containers



Packaging:

- Clear ridged packaging from toys and electronics

Glass

- Food and beverage bottles and jars



Paper

- Phone Books
- Newspaper and inserts
- Magazines & catalogs
- Mail, office & school papers



Boxes:

- Cardboard
- Cereal & cracker boxes
- Shoe boxes, gift boxes
- Toothpaste, medication, toiletry boxes



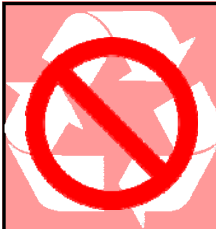
Cartons

- Food & beverage cans
- Foil & Foil pans
